The Hong Kong new listing regime of allowing special purpose acquisition company ("SPAC") to list on the main board of the Hong Kong Stock Exchange has been effective since 1 January 2022 with amendments to the Hong Kong main board listing rules, in particular the addition of new Chapter 18B on SPAC listing.

To strengthen and maintain Hong Kong's reputation and position as the primary financial hub in the Asia, the Hong Kong Stock Exchange has established SPAC listing regime with rules more stringent than other major stock exchange markets.

Background knowledge of SPAC and De-SPAC transaction

A special purpose acquisition company ("SPAC")

is a company that has no commercial operations and is formed strictly to raise capital through an initial public offering ("IPO") for the purpose of acquiring or merging with an existing company in operation. Also known as "blank check company," SPACs have been around for decades, but their popularity has soared in recent years.


De-SPAC Transaction

is an acquisition of, or a business combination with, a De-SPAC Target by a SPAC that results in the listing of a Successor Company.

Successor Company

is the listed issuer resulting from the completion of a De-SPAC Transaction.

In response to the unprecedented COVID-19 outbreak, ROMA has actively taken a number of actions to minimize the potential risks on the health and safety of our employees. Apart from increasing the frequency of office cleaning and sterilization, employees are required to wear surgical face masks in office areas and check their body temperature before entering the office.

We continue to provide surgical masks, COVID-19 rapid test kits, disinfectant and alcohol wipes for our employees and have installed nanofiber air filters and a number of air purifiers in the office so as to enhance the air quality and ventilation. In order to ensure safety of our colleagues, each colleague is required to conduct a COVID-19 self test (Rapid Antigen Test) every working day, work-from-home arrangement has also been adopted.
